Participation in Funding Programs:

Students enrolled in Hawthorn University are not eligible for federal financial aid programs. Some state vocational financial aid funds can be applied to Hawthorn. The California Department of Rehabilitation has funded Hawthorn students in the past, as have California employment insurers. Students may want to check with their state for information on educational grants programs and for private scholarships that may be available. Some employers have tuition remission policies.

Hawthorn students have participated in the Military Spouse Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) program, a workforce development program that provides up to \$4,000 of tuition assistance to eligible military spouses in high-growth, high-demand portable career fields. Other Indicators of Success:

NANP reports that 91% of Hawthorn Graduates that took the HNCB exam passed. The Hawthorn University 2018 Alumni Survey received 314 responses from 486 invitations sent out.

- Eighty-seven percent (87%) or 272 graduates said that the skills obtained through their Hawthorn education helped in their career.

- Eighty two percent (82%) or 182 alumni indicated they had made progress towards completing the goals articulated when starting this program
- Ninety two percent (92%) or 206 alumni indicated they would recommend programs at Hawthorn University to a friend or an acquaintance
- Ninety six percent (96%) or 215 alumni indicated satisfaction with their course of study with Hawthorn.

End-of-Course Surveys are distributed to all enrolled students at the completion of a course. In 2018 sixty-eight (68) surveys were collected on 356 courses released.

- All sixty-eight respondents (100%) indicated they had made progress towards completing the goals articulated when starting this program.
- All sixty-eight students (100%) indicated they would recommend programs at Hawthorn University to a friend or an acquaintance
- Sixty-seven students surveyed indicated satisfaction with their course of study with Hawthorn. One student indicated dissatisfaction.

Recognitions:

The National Association of Nutritional Professionals (NANP) has reviewed and recommends that Hawthorn graduates of the Nutrition Consultant certificate program, Master of Science in Holistic Nutrition, Master of Science in Health & Nutrition Education, Master of Science in Traditional Nutrition, and the Doctor of Science in Holistic Nutrition programs sit for the national board certification exam in Holistic Nutrition from the U.S. Holistic Nutrition Credentialing Board (HNCB). www.hncb.org.
